PARTIAL CLOSURE OF WILLIAMS TO ASSIST REPAIRS **Work to Include Patching, New Curbs & Handicap Ramps**

The Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development announced it will use alternating lane closures on Williams Boulevard between Airline Drive and Interstate-10 from November 1 through November 4, from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. to repair road surfaces, curbs, gutters and handicap ramps.



The following week, November 7 through 15, Williams will receive additional work that includes cold planning and asphalt paving, weather permitting, with expectations for completion prior to Thanksgiving. State Rep. Thomas P. Willmott, who supports the project, joined with DODT officials in asking motorists to be careful when driving through the work area and to be patient while the project is completed.
