CODE SWEEP UNCOVERS 96 VIOLATIONS

Kenner, LA. – Inspectors discovered 96 code violations during a recent sweep within the Highway Park subdivision, officials said.

The sweep included much of 34th Street, as well as the 2900 to 3400 blocks of Maryland, Maine, Iowa and Illinois avenues. The sweep was requested by Mayor Ben Zahn and Councilman Mike Sigur in response to a number of complaints.

"I want to thank Councilman Sigur and our Code Enforcement Department for their diligence in staying on top of these issues," Mayor Ben Zahn said. "I have authorized weekly code sweeps as we continue our 'War on Blight' to make Kenner Proud."

The violations include:

Abandoned vehicles	15
Building permit required	3
Building maintenance needed	7
Soffit/fascia issues	10
Fence repair	6
High grass	15
Litter/debris	12
Repair/demolition required	3
Unsafe electrical conditions	12
Unsafe plumbing conditions	1
Rodent proofing	6
Address required	6
