### **Volunteers needed for Rivertown Clean-Up Day in Kenner**

On Saturday, April 20<sup>th</sup> the Rivertown merchants and business owners, in association with the City of Kenner and Sunburst Media, will hold a Rivertown clean-up day of service. Volunteers will team up into small groups and canvas the Rivertown Historic District for clean-up and trash collection. The staging point will be in the LaSalle Landing parking lot located along Third Street across from Heritage Hall and the event will start at 9:00 am and run no later than noon.

Located at the foot of Williams Boulevard and the Mississippi River, the Rivertown Historic District is home to several buildings located on the National Register of Historic Places. The Kenner Planning Department will oversee the event.
