KENNER FLAGS LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF ON FRIDAY IN HONOR OF PATRIOT DAY

Kenner, LA. – All flags at city buildings in Kenner will be lowered to half-staff on Friday in honor of Patriot Day, Kenner Mayor Michael Yenni announced.

Friday is the 14-year anniversary of the 9/11 terrorist attacks on the Trade Center in New York City, the Pentagon in Washington, D.C. and United Airlines Flight 93, which crashed in suburban Pennsylvania.

In addition to flying American flags at half-staff, President Obama has asked all Americans to observe a moment of silence at 8:46 a.m. Central time, the moment the first plane hit the North Tower of the Trade Center.
