KENNER FLAGS TO BE LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF TO HONOR 9/11 ANNIVERSARY

Kenner, LA. – All U.S. flags on city buildings will be lowered to half-staff on Sunday, Sept. 11 to mark the 15th anniversary of the 9/11 attacks in New York City, Washington D.C. and Pennsylvania, Acting Kenner Mayor Michael Sigur announced.

President Obama has ordered that flags fly at half-staff on Patriot Day; and additionally, the president has requested all Americans to observe a moment of silence beginning at 8:46 a.m. Eastern time (7:46 a.m. New Orleans time – the moment that the first plane struck the North Tower of the World Trade Center.
