AARP PROGRAM OFFERS FREE TAX HELP AT KENNER PAVILION

Kenner, LA. – Free tax preparation help for low and moderate income taxpayers – particularly people 50 years old and older – is now available at the Pavilion at Kenner City Park.

The tax help is part of a nationwide program offered by the AARP Foundation Tax-Aide. It is designed to provide individualized help in filing tax forms with the Internal Revenue Service.

IRS-certified volunteers will be on hand for those who cannot afford a tax preparation service and are concerned about additional tax filing complexities as a result of retirement or other issues.

Taxpayers are asked to bring last year's tax return, a photo ID and Social Security cards or other official documents for themselves and all dependents as well as all forms related to both income and deductions. Hours are 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Thursday; however, there is no tax assistance available on Feb. 8 and 9 – Lundi Gras and Mardi Gras.
