HOTLINE NOW ACTIVATED FOR AIRPORT CONSTRUCTION QUESTIONS, CONCERNS

Kenner, LA. – A hotline for Kenner residents and business owners has been activated by the construction manager in charge of building the new North Terminal at Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport.

The hotline is just one way in which representatives of Hunt-Gibbs-Boh-Metro are attempting to mitigate any impacts as a result of the construction, which is set to be finished in 2018.

Kenner residents and business owners are encouraged to ask any questions about the construction and to report any problems or issues during the construction period. The hotline will be monitored by the construction management team, who will consult with Airport, Kenner and regional representatives to address all questions and issues.
