The concert, by Groovy 7, is part of the *Crawfish Boil on the Lake* event scheduled Friday from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on the front lawn of the Treasure Chest Casino, weather permitting.

The crawfish boil is jointly sponsored by the casino and the City of Kenner. Some of the proceeds go to local charities. Plates with boiled crawfish and fixins are available for \$10 to members of the casino's B Connected club as well as anyone under the age of 15. Anyone not a B connected member can purchase the crawfish for \$15. There also will be beer and other drinks for sale.

The Easter Eggstravaganza is part of the special Rivertown Farmer's Market on Saturday morning. In addition to the freshest in produce and home-made goods, there will be a free Easter egg hunt beginning at 10 a.m. for kids 10 and younger. Pictures with the Easter bunny also are available for \$5.
