CODE SWEEP UNCOVERS 71 VIOLATIONS

Kenner, LA. – A code sweep in the 2600 and 2700 blocks of Augusta and Helena streets Wednesday morning uncovered 71 violations.

Those violations include:

Substandard building	1
Abandoned refrigerators	1
Address required	7
Abandoned vehicles	15
Building permits required	3
Building maintenance required	2
Soffit/fascia repairs needed	10
Fence repair	6
High grass	6
Litter/debris	4
Repair or demolish required	1
Unsafe electrical conditions	10
Window/door/screen repair	3
Vermin/rodent proof	1
Major mechanical	1

Kenner Mayor Ben Zahn said inspectors in the Code Enforcement Department will continue to respond to complaints and to target trouble spots in the city – including both homes and commercial complexes.

“As we continue addressing blight in Kenner, I applaud the actions of the Kenner Code Department,” Zahn said. “These areas that need this attention will continue to have my support until we rid these violations from Kenner.”
