CHRISTMAS VILLAGE IN RIVERTOWN CANCELED TONIGHT

Kenner, LA. – Christmas Village tonight in Rivertown has been canceled because of the stormy weather; however, the weather is expected to cooperate for the final two evenings of the village this weekend, Kenner Mayor Michael Yenni announced Friday.

“I hate to cancel even one day of Christmas Village, particularly because of the crowds we have been seeing so far,” Yenni said. “But hopefully everyone can delay their plans by a day or two and head out to Christmas Village on Saturday or Sunday.”

Kenner’s annual Christmas Village is three weekends of holiday magic, fun, food and entertainment and runs from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. the first three weekends of December. Admission is free

“The incredible Christmas lights will be on throughout Heritage Park, Santa will be available for pictures, ‘snow’ will be falling and both Saturday and Sunday will be filled with great entertainment,” Yenni said.

Yenni said city officials will monitor the weather throughout the weekend in the event there is a change in the forecast for Saturday and Sunday.
