INSPECTORS ISSUE 60 VIOLATIONS DURING MINI CODE SWEEP

Kenner, LA. – A “mini-sweep” of the two blocks of Martinique Street resulted in 60 violations issued to property owners, according to Assistant Inspection & Code Enforcement Director Rick Walther.

The sweep, conducted Wednesday in the 3500 and 3600 blocks of Martinique, was the result of complaints from the neighborhood. Mayor Michael Yenni has directed Walther and Inspection & Code Enforcement Director Aimee Vallot to regularly conduct sweeps throughout the city to ensure that property owners are following city laws.

The following violations were issued:

- Abandoned vehicles – 5
- Fascia/Soffit issues – 6
- High grass – 6
- Litter/debris – 11
- Repair or demolish order requested – 3
- Unsafe electrical conditions – 12
- Boarding required – 1
- Vermin/rodents – 5
- Windows/doors/screens – 4
- Building maintenance – 3
- Fence repair – 4
