### CODE ENFORCEMENT DEPARTMENT CLOSED MONDAY JULY 28<sup>TH</sup> FOR MOVE BACK TO NEWLY RENOVATED HEADQUARTERS

**Kenner, LA.** – The Kenner Code Enforcement Department, temporarily located at 1610 Reverend Richard Wilson Drive since September, will move back to its newly renovated home in Building B of the City Hall complex, 1801 Williams Blvd., and open to the public on Tuesday, July 29.

To accommodate the move, the Code Enforcement Department will be closed on Monday, July 28. On Tuesday morning at 8:30 a.m., the department will reopen to the public, Code Enforcement Director Aimee Vallot said.

“We will be able to better serve the public as a result of the renovations,” Vallot said. “No matter what brings you to the department – a complaint, an occupational license or a building inspection – you can now get all of your business accomplished without having to go to different sections of the office. Our employees also will appreciate a roomier, more comfortable office,” Vallot said.
