MARTINIQUE CODE SWEEP NETS 77 VIOLATIONS

Kenner, LA. – Kenner inspectors uncovered 77 violations during a code sweep on Thursday along two blocks of Martinique Avenue.

The sweep was requested by department official James Mohammad, who had noticed a number of issues with vehicles, residences and debris in the 3500 and 3600 blocks of Martinique.

Code violations included:

- Abandoned refrigerator 1
- Abandoned vehicles 12
- Building maintenance required 11
- Fascia/soffit issues 10
- Fence repair needed 6
- Litter/debris 11
- Unsafe electric conditions 19
- Windows/screens 2
- Address required 2
- Vermin/rodent protection 3

Assistant Code Enforcement Director Rick Walther said the department will continue to conduct occasional unannounced code sweeps.
