FREE COMPUTER KEYBOARDING CLASS AT THE MARTIN LUTHER KING COMMUNITY RESOURCE CENTER

Kenner, LA. - The City of Kenner Community Development Department, in partnership with Operation Hope, is offering a **FREE** (2) two week computer keyboarding course for anyone who wants to learn how to type and use a computer keyboard.

This free two-week course teaches proper finger placement techniques and an overview on how to type different letters, numbers, and symbols without looking at the keyboard. The course is 16 hours over four days.

Classes will begin on Thursday, Feb. 13 and are held on two consecutive Thursdays and Fridays – Feb. 13 - 14 and Feb. 20 - 21. All four classes begin at 10:00 a.m. and run until 2:00 p.m. each day.
