CODE SWEEP UNCOVERS 46 VIOLATIONS

Kenner, LA. – Inspectors from the Department of Inspection & Code Enforcement discovered 46 code violations during a recent sweep of the 3000-3100 blocks of Acron, Albany and Dawson streets, officials said.

Those violations included:

Abandoned vehicles	14
Building maintenance required	2
Soffit/fascia issues	9
Fence repair	2
Address required	2
High grass	2
Illegal discharge	1
Litter/debris	5
Repair or demolition needed	3
Unsafe electrical conditions	3
Windows/screens	2
Vermin/rodent proofing	1

Property owners are allowed a period of time to come into compliance prior to receiving a summons to show up in court and come into forced compliance with the city's code laws. Property owners also could face fines and court costs. After compliance is confirmed, the property owners may be put on probation for as long as a year. If there is a repeat violation, the property owners can be recharged under the original violation.

Kenner Mayor Ben Zahn said code sweeps have been a priority this year and promised that will continue 2018.
