TREES, OTHER IMPROVEMENTS TO KENNER'S DOG PARK

Kenner, LA. – Kenner's Dog Park now has 10 new trees and additional beautification and summer preparation plans are in the works, Kenner Mayor Ben Zahn and District 5 Councilwoman Kelly Hand said.

The beautiful trees were donated from Charvet's Garden Center. There are a pair of 20-foot Cypress trees, two 18-foot Japanese Magnolias and six Mary Nell Holly trees. In addition, a new drainage system has been installed near the entrance to the park to alleviate some pooling issues.

To prepare the park, which opened in October, for its first summer season, a dog washing station has been installed, and there are plans to add pergolas to provide shade over some of the benches in the coming weeks.

"More and more people seem to be discovering the city's first-ever dog park," District 5 Councilwoman Kelly Hand said. "I'm confident these improvements will be very well received."

Kenner Mayor Ben Zahn said it's important that dog owners don't have to leave the city to spend some time in a quality dog park.

"We will continue to work on upgrades to this excellent facility," he said.
