### **DYNAMIC MESSAGE SIGNS TO BE INSTALLED ALONG LOYOLA DR. AND WILLIAMS BLVD.**

**Kenner, LA.** – As part of an Entity/State Agreement between the State DOTD, City of Kenner and the New Orleans Regional Planning Commission, a number of Dynamic Message Signs will soon be installed at several locations along Loyola Dr. and Williams Blvd. Purpose for these signs is to alert motorists of any traffic congestion along I-10 eastbound and westbound.

This project will improve mobility and travel time savings, will provide enhanced safety and a reduction in environmental emissions and noise. During emergencies, these signs will also provide critical traveler information for efficient evacuation of residents, said Kenner Public Works Director Jose Gonzalez.

Ernest P. Breaux Electrical is the contractor on the project, which is expected to require short duration lane closures during non-peak hour traffic periods.

The signs which will be located at Loyola Dr. southbound near Furman Dr., Williams Blvd. northbound immediately north of West Napoleon Ave. and Williams Blvd. southbound immediately south of Driftwood Blvd. are expected to be completed within three (3) months.
