Kenner announces available registration for FEMA Individual Assistance Program

Mayor Yenni participated in conference calls this afternoon with President Barack Obama and top White House officials, including Homeland Security Secretary, Janet Napolitano, and Craig Fugate, Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). These officials indicated the federal government's commitment to provide all possible resources to those affected by Hurricane Isaac.

FEMA will be sending representatives to designated locations in the area for those who are not able to register via telephone or internet. Those dates, times, and locations will be announced once determined by FEMA.

Although specific assistance programs will be disclosed once they are determined by FEMA, registration for the Individual Assistance Program is encouraged at this time.
