CODE INSPECTORS UNCOVER 154 VIOLATIONS IN TWO CODE SWEEPS

Kenner, LA. – Members of the Inspection and Complaint division of the Kenner Code Enforcement Department uncovered 154 code violations during a pair of sweeps conducted recently.

One of the sweeps focused on the 3500 and 3600 blocks of Martinique Street and was the result of complaints received by Code officials regarding this multi-family residential area. The second sweep included the 600-800 blocks of Vouray Drive and the 3500- 3800 blocks of Martinique Street.

The following violations were discovered the sweep of the 3500 and 3600 blocks of Martinique:

Property owners are identified during the sweeps and are summoned to court and ordered to come into compliance with Kenner’s code laws, often facing fines and court costs. Even for those property owners in compliance, they are placed on probation and if there is a repeat violation they can be recharged under the original violation.

Kenner Mayor Ben Zahn and Code Enforcement Director Rick Walther urged residents to call with any complaints about code issues in their neighborhood.

“These two sweeps both involved areas that we have visited before, and due to continuing complaints, were again the focus of code inspectors,” Mayor Zahn said. “Rick Walther and his department takes every complaint we receive seriously, and as these sweeps indicate, we will not hesitate to take action to enforce the code laws in the city.”
