FREE FIREWORKS AND PATRIOTIC MUSIC HIGHLIGHT HOLIDAY WEEKEND IN KENNER

Kenner, LA. - A long, holiday weekend filled with special events in Kenner begins Thursday night with a fireworks show at the lakefront and includes a special production of patriotic music in Rivertown by the *Victory Belles*.

The free fireworks show, sponsored by the Treasure Chest Casino and the City of Kenner begins about 9:30 p.m. and will last about 30 minutes. Spectators can watch from different locations in Laketown, or for anyone 21 and older, from any of the three decks of the Treasure Chest riverboat casino.

Beginning on July 4, the popular vocal trio from the National World War II Museum, *The Victory Belles*, will perform the first of three shows at the Rivertown Theaters for the Performing Arts, 325 Minor St.
