### *HEAT INDEX FORECAST TO APPROACH 110 DEGREES BEGINNING ON THURSDAY*

**Kenner, LA.** – Some of the hottest weather of the summer is expected beginning on Thursday, and residents are urged to remain hydrated and be smart when it comes to outdoor activities during the hottest times of the day.

The temperature could approach the upper 90s on Thursday, with a heat index possible in the 105 to 110-degree range. The extreme heat is expected to remain in the area through Sunday, according to the National Weather Service.

While there is a 20 to 30 percent chance of rain and thunderstorms the next few days, these will be isolated and will only affect the temperature briefly.
