#### **Household Hazardous Materials and Electronic Waste Collection Event to be Held in Jefferson Parish Saturday, July 19, 2014**

The Jefferson Parish Department of Environmental Affairs, with grant funding from the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ), and in conjunction with the Capital Area Corporate Recycling Council (CACRC) and The Green Project, will collect household hazardous materials from Jefferson Parish residents on Saturday, July 19, 2014.

The collection event will take place in the parking lot of the Joseph S. Yenni Building, 1221 Elmwood Park Boulevard, 9:00 am - 12:00 noon. Residents should enter from the Citrus Boulevard side of the property.

**Only** the following items **WILL BE** accepted:

**Mercury-Containing Equipment:** thermostats, thermometers and elemental mercury.

**Paint:** Latex coatings, oil paint, varnishes, and wood preservers in original container.

**Lawn & Garden Products:** including pesticides, herbicides, fungicides, fertilizers, bug sprays.

**Household Cleaning Products:** Cleaning solvents, corrosive cleaners, oven cleaners, drain cleaners, disinfectants, degreasers.

**Electronic Waste:** computers, monitors, printers, radios, camcorders, VCR's, CD players, DVD players, MP3 players, telephones, stereos, Xboxes, PlayStations, Wii, digital cameras and digital video cameras, digital picture frames, portable navigation and GPS devices (Garmin, Magellan, Tom-Tom), fax machines, circuit boards (of any type), processors, uninterruptible power supplies (UPS), toner cartridges, ink jet cartridges.

**COMMERCIAL WASTE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT THIS EVENT.**

**The following materials WILL NOT be accepted:**

- Non-residential waste of any kind
- Televisions
- Copy Machines
- Styrofoam, including peanuts
- Ammunition
- Power Tools
- Fluorescent and Neon Light Bulbs and Lighting Ballasts
- Propane tanks

**The following materials will not be accepted at this event, but may be recycled by bringing them to the David Drive or Lapalco Boulevard Trash Drop-off Sites:**

- Antifreeze, oil & other used automotive fluids
- Appliances
- Used automotive batteries
