### JEFFERSON PARISH COUNCIL TO HOLD MEETING IN KENNER ON OCT. 5

**Kenner, LA.** – For the 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive year, the Jefferson Parish Council will hold a regular, bi-monthly meeting in Kenner – conducting business at the Kenner City Council Chambers on Oct. 5.

Presentations begin at 9:30 a.m. and the meeting starts at 10 a.m.

Acting Kenner Mayor Michael Sigur said the meeting is a great opportunity for Kenner residents to easily meet and talk with their Jefferson Parish leaders. At the same time, it's a good opportunity for Kenner officials to ensure parish leaders are well aware of issues important to Kenner.

"We've had a very good relationship with the Parish Council for some time, and of course, with Mike Yenni as Parish President, we expect that to continue," Sigur said. "I am honored for the city to be able to host this meeting, and I hope residents take the opportunity to attend this meeting, if they are able."

The Parish Council first met in Kenner in 2012, and a yearly rotation to different locations throughout the city followed – such as the City Park Pavilion and Rivertown's Heritage Hall. The meeting returns to the Council Chambers this year, the same location as the initial meeting four years ago.

Yenni and Jefferson Parish 4<sup>th</sup> District Councilman Ben Zahn were behind the effort to hold at least one yearly parish meeting in Kenner.
