SCHEDULE CHANGE FOR KENNER COUNCIL MEETINGS

Kenner, LA. – The starting times for Kenner City Council meetings have been changed on a six-month trial basis that begins with the first meeting in October.

Meetings will now start at 6 p.m. on the first Thursday of the month and 11 a.m. on the third Friday of each month. All council meetings are held in the City Council Chambers, 1801 Williams Blvd.

The change was approved unanimously at the Sept. 6 City Council meeting and becomes effective in 17 days. That means the new schedule will first be used for the October meetings. The first meeting will be at 6 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 4. The second meeting in October will be 11 a.m. on Friday, Oct. 19.

The six-month trial period extends through March of 2019. Kenner council members have said the goal is to allow more residents to attend council meetings. Attendance during the six-month trial will be studied, and a decision will be made whether to make the new schedule permanent or consider a change.

The next Kenner City Council meeting under the current schedule is Thursday, Sept. 20 at 5 p.m.
