Kenner Experiencing Street Flooding Due to Heavy Rainfall

Kenner, LA – Kenner Public Works crews and the Kenner Police department are addressing street flooding in areas of north Kenner as a result of heavy rainfall in the past 3 hours.

The National Weather Service has issued a flash flood warning for the area until 3 p.m.

Public Works Director Jose Gonzalez has been in touch with Jefferson Parish Drainage and confirmed all pumps are functioning and were turned on at the appropriate times. Public Works crews are out evaluating the area.

High water has been reported in the following areas:

**4400 block Lake Trail
4200 block Connecticut
4200 block Alabama
Gelpi from Driftwood Blvd to Coronado
Power Blvd NB and SB Vintage to I10.
Chateau and Vintage**

Motorists are urged to avoid these areas and should not drive through flooded streets; extra caution advised for low profile vehicles and along open canals.
