### **KENNER OFFICES CLOSED AT 2 P.M., AIRPORT MEETING RESCHEDULED DUE TO WEATHER**

**Kenner, LA.** – Acting Kenner Mayor Michael Sigur has ordered that all Kenner offices close at 2 p.m. today because of the forecast for potentially severe weather during the afternoon and evening.

In addition, a meeting for Kenner residents living near the construction area for the new North Terminal to hear about construction and traffic plans has been rescheduled for 6 p.m. March 1 at Susan Park Gym, 502 Veterans Blvd. The meeting was to be held tonight at 6 p.m. at Susan Park.

District 1 Councilman Gregory Carroll and Sigur said public safety is the overriding concern for postponing the airport meeting and closing city offices early. The storms, some of which could be severe, are forecast to arrive during the afternoon hours and continue into the early evening, according to the National Weather Service.

Weather forecasters said Tuesday that high winds, hail, lightning and the chance of tornadoes are possible during the day as the system moves through the area.
