FREE CONCERT AND MOVIE IN RIVERTOWN HIGHLIGHT BUSY WEEKEND

Kenner, LA. – The first weekend in May means the debut of Music in the Park on Friday night followed by Movies in the Park on Saturday night – both in Heritage Park in Rivertown.

The free music and movie series are annually held on weekends in May and have grown tremendously in popularity in recent years.

“What a great way to start this free series – the weather is expected to be absolutely perfect all weekend long,” Kenner Acting Mayor Michael Sigur said. “Enjoy the Topcats on Friday night and come back Saturday night in the park for ‘Minions.’”

Families are urged to bring blankets and chairs to stake out a spot in the park. Food and drinks, along with other concessions, will be on sale so no outside food or drink is allowed. In addition, pets are not allowed to either the free concert or movie.

The Topcats concert begins at 6:30 p.m. and runs to 9:30 p.m. while the movie on Saturday begins at 8 p.m. For more information on either free event, call (504) 468-7231.

This year, the first weekend in May also means the culmination of the first week of curbside recycling collection in Kenner in more than 10 years. Residents who get their garbage picked up curbside are also part of the once-weekly recycling collection.

Recycling falls on the second garbage day of the week for residents, which means it is on either Thursday, Friday or Saturday.

There’s other fun going on in Rivertown this weekend, including the musical “How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying” at Rivertown Theaters for the Performing Arts. Director Gary Rucker’s take on this Tony and Pulitzer Prize-winning Broadway classic begins Friday at 8 p.m.
