ROAD PROJECT ON SOUTHBOUND LANES OF LOYOLA DRIVE

Kenner, LA. – Motorists are advised that two of the three southbound lanes of Loyola Drive, between Vintage Drive and West Esplanade Avenue, will be closed for much of the next two weeks to accommodate a road restoration project.

The closures of the left and center lanes began today (Wednesday) and are expected to continue for up to two weeks, assuming the project isn't delayed by weather or other unforeseen complications. One southbound lane, at least, will remain open at all times.

Traffic control signs and devices have been put out by the contractor Boh Brothers Construction, to alert motorists, who are encouraged to consider alternate routes to avoid any traffic delays.
