### **ONE LANE OF LOYOLA DRIVE CLOSED IN ADVANCE OF SEWER WORK**

**Kenner, LA.** – Motorists will find that the left, southbound lane on Loyola Drive between Vintage Drive and West Esplanade Avenue has been closed in advance of sewer force main repair work at the sewer lift station in that area.

The work is expected to begin on Monday, March 16, said Assistant Public Works Director Bill Duplaisir. The lane is being closed a few days in advance of the project because a cavity was detected under the lane due to a sewer-related issue. The closing of the lane is out of an abundance of caution, officials said.

Only the left lane of southbound Loyola will be closed. The middle and right lanes will remain open during the duration of the project, expected to be finished by March 20, Duplaisir said.

Traffic control devices, including warning signs and barricades, are in place in the construction area.
