TWO LANES OF LOYOLA DRIVE CLOSED FOR SEWER WORK

Kenner, LA. – Two of the southbound lanes of Loyola Drive, between Vintage Drive and West Esplanade Avenue, will be closed through Friday to accommodate sewer force main repair work at the sewer lift station in that area.

Initially, only the left lane of southbound Loyola was to be closed. However, the contractor determined that was not enough room for heavy equipment to move around safely, Kenner Public Works Director Jose Gonzalez said. “Out of an abundance of caution, the decision was made to close two lanes.”

Gonzalez said roadway restoration will follow the sewer repair work. However, the right lane will remain open at all times, at a minimum, during the duration of the project, Gonzalez said.

Traffic control devices, including warning signs and barricades, are in place in the construction area.
