KENNER HOSTS FREE LUNDI GRAS CELEBRATION ON FEB. 16 IN RIVERTOWN

Kenner, LA. – Lundi Gras in Kenner, highlighted by the meeting of the courts of the Krewe of Argus of Metairie and the Zulu Social Aid and Pleasure Club of New Orleans, starts at 11 a.m. on Feb. 16 in Rivertown with a free party.

This is the 17th year for Kenner’s popular Lundi Gras celebration. Music will be provided by *Papa C and the Slammin Horns* from 11:30 until the party ends at 3 p.m. The public is invited to attend the event, which includes booths set up by local vendors selling everything from food to crafts.

“This is just a great way to get ready for Fat Tuesday,” Kenner Mayor Michael Yenni said. “There is the tradition of the meeting of the courts of these two prominent Carnival groups, and of course, a free party as well. I hope we fill up Rivertown for this great event.”

Yenni and members of the City Council will be on stage in the parking lot across from Exhibition Hall in the 400 block of Williams Boulevard to welcome the royal courts of the two Carnival krewes. The mayor will offer a special welcoming toast at noon.
