Kenner, LA. – A The 30th annual Martin Luther King Jr. celebration, which features a parade in south Kenner, will begin Monday at 11 a.m. at Providence Baptist Church, 11509 Jefferson Highway.

The parade will head down Jefferson Highway to the Arthur P. Clay Center, 200 Decatur St., located at the corner of Rev. Richard Wilson Drive and Decatur. A program will follow.
