APPLICATIONS EXTENDED TO MAY 11 FOR 2016-17 MAYOR'S YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL

Kenner, LA. – The registration period to apply for the 2016-17 Mayor's Youth Advisory Council has been extended to May 11.

The Youth Council, formed in 2013, is for Kenner residents that attend high school anywhere in the metropolitan area or are home-schooled in the city, said Kenner Deputy Chief Administrative Officer Maria Leon.

"We understand this is a very busy time for high school students, so we wanted to provide some additional time," Leon said.

To qualify for the Youth Council, kids must be between the ages of 14 and 19, live in Kenner and have a strong interest in civic participation and the process of working toward community solutions. The term is a year and members are not allow more than three unexcused absences.

Applications are available on the city's website, www.kenner.la.us. Prospective members must include two reference letters and a parent consent form along with the application.
