CODE SWEEP ON MARTINIQUE AVENUE UNCOVERS 95 VIOLATIONS

Kenner, LA. – Inspectors with the Kenner Code Department found 95 code violations during a sweep Wednesday morning of the 3500 and 3600 blocks of Martinique Avenue, Kenner officials said.

Property owners will be notified and summons will be issued to enforce compliance of the violations, Kenner Mayor Ben Zahn said.

The violations include:

Abandoned refrigerators	2
Abandoned vehicles	12
Address required	3
Building maintenance required	14
Fascia/soffit repairs	12
Fence repair	7
High grass	4
Garbage cans	8
Litter/debris	15
Unsafe electrical conditions	13
Vermin/rodent proofing	5

“Today a code sweep of Martinique from Driftwood Boulevard to West Esplanade Avenue was conducted,” Zahn said. “This area has continued to be a detriment to the Driftwood neighborhood due to its consistent code violations.

“Frequent code sweeps on streets in our city that continue to defy our codes will be conducted often by my administration. We will continue to have a no-tolerance approach to repeat offenders and rid our city of blight. Driftwood Subdivision deserves property owners who follow the code as they do.”
