MORE FREE FUN AVAILABLE THIS WEEKEND IN KENNER

Kenner, LA. – If “free” and “family fun” sound like a good pairing, consider a concert or movie this weekend in Rivertown – both absolutely free.

On Friday, from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m., the *Topcats* will perform in Heritage Park in Rivertown as part of the Music in the Park concert series. A day later in Heritage Park, bring the family to watch *Night at the Museum – Secret of the Tomb*. The free movie begins at 8 p.m. and will be shown on a 25-foot outdoor screen. Both Music in the Park and Movies in the Park are offered each May, and the two free events have been growing in popularity.

“It’s clear that people appreciate having some quality choices for the whole family,” Kenner Mayor Michael Yenni said. “The crowds have been wonderful.”
