## HOLLY HEIGHTS CODE SWEEP UNCOVERS 22 VIOLATIONS

**Kenner, LA.** – Inspectors discovered 22 violations during a code enforcement sweep in the Holly Heights neighborhood Thursday morning.

The sweep was requested by District 4 Councilman Lenny Cline. Mayor Ben Zahn has ordered frequent code sweeps of both businesses and commercial complexes since taking office in January to attack blight and let property owners know they cannot ignore their obligations.

"It's important for residents to know that if they have concerns about their neighborhood, we will be active and do all we can to address those concerns," Cline said.

The violations in Thursday's sweep include:

Abandoned vehicles	5
Vehicles located in rear yards	5
Building permit required	1
Building/maintenance issues	1
Fence repair	5
Litter/debris	2
Repair or demolition necessary	1
Soffit/fascia issues	1
Dirt to be spread	1

Mayor Ben Zahn said residents and property owners can expect code sweeps to continue.

"As we continue our efforts to rid the City of blight, I applaud the consistent work of our Code Director, Code Enforcement officers, Councilman Cline and my administration," Zahn said. "These persistent violations
