### FREE BLOCK PARTY FRIDAY IN RIVERTOWN HIGHLIGHTS WEEKEND CHOICES

**Kenner, LA.** – Friday’s Music in the Park event in Rivertown features twice the music and plenty of extra room to dance and party, Kenner Mayor Michael Yenni announced.

Music in the Park has been moved to Williams Boulevard in Rivertown for a Big Block Party that includes two bands. *Remedy* will start the block party at 6 p.m. and play until 7 p.m. About 15 minutes later, Papa C and the Slammin’ Horns will take over and play until 9:30 p.m.

“This is a great way to end what has been a fantastic month of May in Kenner,” Yenni said. “The concerts and the free movies have been very well received, and the AVP pro beach volleyball tournament last weekend in Laketown was a huge success.”

Concessions will be on sale Friday so no outside food and drink will be allowed.

There is a chance of rain on Friday as well as Saturday, when *Penguins of Madagascar* will be shown as part of Movies in the Park. The movie, on a 25-foot outdoor screen, starts at 8 p.m. in Heritage Park in Rivertown. Lawn chairs and blankets are welcomed, but no outside food or drink and no pets.
