### MUSIC IN THE PARK SCHEDULED FOR TONIGHT IN RIVERTOWN IS CANCELED

**Kenner, LA.** - Tonight's Music in the Park event in Rivertown featuring the band *August Rush* has been canceled because of threatening weather, Kenner Mayor Michael Yenni announced.

"I hate to have to call off tonight's free concert, but the weather forecast calls for a 100 percent chance of rain this evening with the potential for very strong storms," he said. "Safety has to be our first concern."

Music in the Park features live bands performing in Heritage Park every Friday in May and has become one of the city's most popular yearly events. Yenni said Kenner officials will continue to monitor the weather forecast to determine if Saturday's Movies in the Park event in Rivertown should also be canceled.

Yenni urged anyone interested in attending Movies in the Park on Saturday to watch *Despicable Me 2* at 8 p.m. in Heritage Park to monitor the city's website, [www.kenner.la.us](http://www.kenner.la.us), as well as the city's Facebook for the latest news.

Music in the Park will return on May 16<sup>th</sup> featuring the band *Mojeaux*. *Papa C and the Slammin Horns* will perform on May 23 and *The Topcats* take the stage on May 30.
