KENNER CODE SWEEP UNCOVERS 87 VIOLATIONS

Kenner, LA. – Inspectors with the Code Enforcement Department found 87 violations during a recent code sweep of the 2600 and 2700 blocks of Albany and Acron streets, officials said.

Those violations included:

Abandoned vehicles	12
Building permit required	4
Building maintenance required	16
Soffit/fascia issues	7
Fence repair	2
Address required	9
High grass	5
Litter/debris	18
Oversized vehicles	1
Occupational license required	1
Stagnant water	1
Unsafe electrical conditions	5
Rodent proofing	4
Windows/doors/screens	2

As a result of the sweep, property owners are summoned to court and forced to come into compliance with Kenner’s code laws. Often, these property owners also face fines and court costs. After the property owners come into compliance, they are placed on probation, and if the violation is repeated, can be recharged under the original violation.

Kenner Mayor Ben Zahn promised there will be no break in code enforcement during the holiday season.
