KENNER CODE SWEEPS UNCOVER 176 VIOLATIONS

Kenner, LA. – Inspectors from Kenner’s Code Enforcement Division uncovered 176 violations during a pair of recent code sweeps in the city, officials said.

A sweep of the 3500 to 3700 blocks of Martinique Avenue was scheduled after receiving complaints from nearby residents. A total of 89 code violations were uncovered:

Abandoned refrigerator	1
Abandoned vehicles	3
Address required	3
Building maintenance required	22
Soffit/fascia issues	10
Fence repair	8
Litter/debris	17
Unsafe electrical conditions	11
Unsafe plumbing conditions	1
Windows/doors/screens	5
Vermin/rodent proofing	8

During a sweep of the 2600 and 2700 block of Albany and Acron Street, inspectors uncovered 87 violations. They included:

Abandoned vehicles	12
Building permit required	4
Building maintenance required	16

As a result of the sweeps, property owners are summoned to court and forced to come into compliance with Kenner's code laws. Often, these property owners also face fines and court costs. Even following the property owners coming into compliance, they are placed on probation, and if the violation is repeated, they can be recharged under the original violation.

Kenner Mayor Ben Zahn urged residents to continue to call the Code Enforcement Department with any concerns about code issues in their neighborhood.

"We are going out on a weekly basis to send a strong message to property owners and residents that the city's code enforcement rules must be followed," Zahn said. "We appreciate residents letting us know areas of concern in the city."
