PEDESTRIAN PATH ON BRIDGE OVER DUNCAN CANAL CLOSED FOR THREE MONTHS

Kenner, LA. – The south side of the pedestrian path that is part of the bridge over the Duncan Canal at 32nd Street, located just in front of The Esplanade mall, will be blocked off for approximately three months as a Goodyear tire store is relocated to that area.

Contractors preparing the site for the new Goodyear facility decided it would be safer to block the southside pedestrian path, said Kenner Assistant Public Works Director Bill Duplaisir.

There is currently no sidewalk in that area, and Goodyear officials will be adding a sidewalk as part the store relocation work, Duplaisir said.

“The area will be safer once the sidewalk is installed, and we and our Code Enforcement Department agreed with the contractors that it would be a good idea to block that pedestrian path,” Duplaisir said.
