The RAAD- Inaugural Rivertown Art After Dark Exhibition

Kenner, LA, The Rivertown Arts Council will host The RAAD, Rivertown Art After Dark on June 25th, 2016 from 6:00 P.M. until 9:00 P.M., 409 Williams Blvd., Kenner, LA.

The RAAD exhibition will feature new mixed media paintings by local artists including mural artists Cheri Ben-lesau, Peter Barnitz, Katie Puchot and Dianne Georgy Garrett. The opening event will center on a ribbon cutting dedication of the Rivertown Arts Council courtyard, which will host future art-centric events, including a continually updated display of murals from local artists. The venue will include food provided by local gourmet food-trucks, a wine and beer cash bar, and music by artist Jenna Hunts.

Prints and original art will also be available for sale, with a percentage of the proceeds going to support the work of the Rivertown Arts Council, a nonprofit entity whose mission is to work in partnership with the City of Kenner, community groups, governmental agencies, and other nonprofit arts organizations to meet the arts and cultural needs of the Kenner community.
