RESIDENT MEETING TO DISCUSS NORTH TERMINAL CONSTRUCTION RESCHEDULED

Kenner, LA. – The meeting for Kenner residents discussing the new north terminal at Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport has been rescheduled for 6 p.m. March 1 at Susan Park Gym, 502 Veterans Blvd. The meeting which was to be held Tuesday February 23, 2016 at 6 p.m. at Susan Park, had to be rescheduled due to the severe weather which affected the area this week.

The purpose of the meeting is to provide information about the construction of a new north terminal at Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport and its impact on Kenner residents. Representatives of Hunt-Gibbs-Boh-Metro, the construction manager on the \$650 million north terminal project, will lay out a general plan for the project, which is expected to be completed in 2018. They will also introduce the traffic plan designed to minimize impact on businesses and families close to the construction area and answer any and all questions.
