KENNER RESTAURANT WEEK: WHERE TO EAT TODAY

Kenner, LA. - If you like combining charity with a good meal, 2 Amigos Mexican Buffet and LaBella's Catering are the places to eat the next three days in Kenner.

This is Day 5 of *Restaurant Week* in Kenner, which started June 4 and continues through Wednesday.

During the weeklong period, anyone eating at a participating restaurant while the promotion is in effect need only mention the Mayor's Youth Advisory Council, or MYAC, to have a percentage of the meal donated to benefit Kenner Recreation and the playground in Veteran's Park.

Between 10:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. at LaBella's Catering, 2118 3rd St., 15 percent of the meal will be donated to the Mayor's Youth Advisory Council; and from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m., 2 Amigos, 3826 Williams Blvd., will give 10 percent of meals to benefit Veteran's Park when customers mention the MYAC. Both businesses will participate in the promotion today, Tuesday and Wednesday.

The Youth Council is made up of 20 teens interested in learning about how local government works and giving back to their community. Restaurant Week is a way for the group to raise money for a charitable service project: the rebuild of Veteran's Park.

"It's really impressive that these teens want to create a tradition of service projects for future Youth Councils," Mayor Michael Yenni said. "I want to thank the restaurants that are participating, and I hope they are packed with customers wanting to help Veterans Park and the Kenner Recreation Department."
