KENNER RESTAURANT WEEK: WHERE TO EAT TODAY

Kenner, LA. –Today is the final day of *Restaurant Week* in Kenner and the last chance to turn a meal into a charitable shot in the arm for Kenner Recreation and the playground in Veteran’s Park.

Customers of LaBella’s Catering and 2 Amigos Mexican Buffet can get a portion of the cost of their meals donated by simply mentioning the Mayor’s Youth Advisory Council, or MYAC.

Between 10:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. at LaBella’s, 2118 3rd St., 15 percent of meals will be donated to the Mayor’s Youth Advisory Council; and from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m., 2 Amigos, 3826 Williams Blvd., will give 10 percent of meals to benefit Veteran’s Park when customers mention the MYAC. *Restaurant Week* started on June 4.

The Youth Council is made up of 20 teens interested in learning about how local government works and giving back to their community. *Restaurant Week* is a way for the group to raise money for a charitable service project: the rebuild of Veteran’s Park.

“It’s really impressive that these teens want to create a tradition of service projects for future Youth Councils,” Mayor Michael Yenni said. “I want to thank the restaurants that are participating, and I hope they are packed with customers wanting to help Veterans Park and the Kenner Recreation Department.”
