SOFTWARE UPGRADE AFFECTS CODE ENFORCEMENT SERVICES ON FRIDAY

Kenner, LA. – Due to a scheduled upgrade of a key software system, the Code Enforcement Department will not be able to process any permits or licenses on Friday, Oct. 14, officials announced.

In addition, department workers will be unable to process payments on permits or licenses on Friday and will not be able to close permits. The upgrade of the software system also means it will not be possible to view inspections on Friday, which means inspections that may be necessary cannot be scheduled.

Kenner Acting Mayor Michael Sigur and Code Enforcement Director Stephen Petit said services should only be affected on Friday. “Everything will be back to normal on Monday.” Sigur said.

No other city departments will be affected, Sigur said.
