TOWN HALL MEETING ABOUT KENNER STREETS MILLAGE RENEWAL ON WEDNESDAY

Kenner, LA. – A town hall meeting to provide information about the Kenner streets millage renewal on the March 25th ballot will be held Wednesday at the City Park Pavilion, 3800 Loyola Drive, at 7 p.m.

This millage, which generates about \$2.7 million a year for the maintenance and repair of city streets, was first approved in 2003. The renewal, if approved would be for 10 years.

"This is not a new tax, just a continuation of something that property owners have been paying for some time," Kenner Mayor Ben Zahn said. "I urge anyone with questions about this existing tax to come to Wednesday's presentation, and I hope everyone shows up to vote on March 25."

Wednesday's town hall also is a regular meeting of the Chateau Lakefront Civic Association. A presentation on the streets millage renewal will be the first order of business, and the civic association meeting will follow.
