

## KENNER TO HOLD ONLINE TAX SALE ON SEPT. 16 and 17, REGISTRATION BEGINS SEPT. 1

Kenner will conduct an online tax sale beginning at 10 a.m. on Sept. 16 and continuing through 3 p.m. on Sept. 17.

The city normally holds in-person tax sales, but due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this year's tax sale will be held online.

The city has contracted with SRI, Inc. to conduct the 2020 Tax Title Sale of 2017 delinquent taxes. SRI, based in Indianapolis, IND., has been conducting tax lien sales throughout the country for more than 25 years and has been working in Louisiana since 2015.

The auction will be held through SRI's Zeus Auction Program at [www.zeusauction.com](http://www.zeusauction.com). Registration with the Zeus program website and for the Kenner tax auction is required and can be done on the Zeus auction website. To view the items in the auction, go to:
