KENNER CAMPS OFFERED DURING THANKSGIVING SCHOOL HOLIDAY

Kenner, LA. – Kenner’s Parks & Recreation Department is putting on a pair of camps for kids to enjoy during the weeklong Thanksgiving holiday while the Rivertown Theaters for the Performing Arts also is holding a camp during the week off from school.

A Thanksgiving camp for ages 4 to 11 begins Monday at Butch Duhe Gym, 1710 10th St. The camp runs from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. through Wednesday and the cost is \$20 per day. The camp will include indoor and outdoor games, arts and crafts, field trips and more. Both before- and after-care is available and included in the fee. Kids will need to bring a bagged lunch each day to camp.

A three-day cheerleading mini-camp for ages 6-13 will begin Monday at Barbre Gym, 1610 3rd St. This camp will teach basic cheering techniques, along with tumbling and stunts. Campers will learn a short routine to show off to parents on the last day of mini-camp. Camp hours are 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and the cost is \$50.

Another three-day camp – this one for kids 7-12 that want to learn more about the theatre – begins Monday at the Rivertown Theaters for the Performing Arts, 325 Minor St. Camp hours are 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. from Monday, Nov. 24 to Wednesday, Nov. 26. The cost is \$225 and includes theatre games, monologue coaching, instruction in set design and costume design as well as open scenes and improvisational training.
