MAYOR BEN ZAHN ORDERS CITY OFFICES CLOSED ON WEDNESDAY

Kenner, LA. – Mayor Ben Zahn reports that Kenner’s Emergency Operations Center has been activated to a Level 1 active monitoring status. At a Level 1 activation, minimum staffing is required at the EOC.

Mayor Zahn has ordered that all Kenner city government offices be closed on Wednesday, June 21, and that only designated, essential personnel report to work. A decision on the status of city offices for Thursday, June 22, will be made during the day on Wednesday.

Kenner Police Chief Mike Glaser says that all police administrative offices will be closed on Wednesday. Only non-essential police personnel will not report to work on Wednesday, and Chief Glaser said he also will make a decision on Wednesday about the status of police administrative offices on Thursday.

For Kenner City Court, individuals with court dates on Wednesday will be rescheduled and the new court date will be mailed to them. Any payments that are scheduled for Wednesday can be made up on the next scheduled date.

Garbage collection will go on as scheduled on Wednesday. However, officials with Ramelli Waste ask that residents do not put out any large debris until Wednesday’s pickup is completed.

All City Council offices will be available by phone on Wednesday.

A Kenner Help Line will be activated tonight and Wednesday for residents who need for non-emergency city services. The Help Line is (504) 468-4357. Citizens with emergencies should call 911.
